MARK YOUR CALENDAR and plan on attending one of these sessions. If you cannot attend one of the tryout dates, contact a league official before that date. Session times will be by age group. ALL PLAYERS who are league age 8 and older **MUST** try out for assessment of proper league and placement.

4/5 and 5/6 years old: Each player must spend one season in their respective division before advancing.

6 and 7 year old girls: Will be assigned to a farm softball team unless the parent indicates they want their daughter to play coed T-ball. 7-year old girls with 1 year of Farm or T-Ball experience have the option to attend tryouts for Minor league teams, but they may not be selected to play in that division.

6 and 7 year old boys: Players with 1 year of T-ball experience may sign up for Farm Division Baseball (no tryout required). Players who have not played before will play in the T-ball Division.

GASTINEAU CHANNEL LITTLE LEAGUE Frequently Asked Questions

When does registration begin? January 2021 through March 27th (Baseball Minors and above, registration cutoff is March 7th). Players registering after March 27th may be placed on a waiting list.

Does my child need to attend tryouts? Players league age 8-16 **must** attend 1 tryout session, even if they've played before. Girls league age 7 may sign up for Farm (no tryout required) or try out for Minors.

When are tryouts? Dates and locations for baseball and softball tryouts are listed on the previous page. Visit www.JuneauLittleLeague.com or www.facebook.com/GCLLAK/ to see times for each league age group.

When will I find out what team my child will play on? All players who register by March 27th and try out (if required) should be contacted by their team manager no later than April 15th. If you don't hear from a team manager by April 18th, please contact the Chief Player Agent at PlayerAgent@JuneauLittleLeague.Com

How are teams formed? T-Ball/Farm teams are formed based on player age and school attended/neighborhood. We honor special placement requests when feasible. All other divisions, players attend tryouts for skill evaluation. Teams are then formed using a draft process to promote parity and competitive play.

When will the season begin? When allowed by CBJ Parks and Recreation, depending on weather and field conditions. Practices usually begin the last week of April or first week of May. Opening Day tentatively set for April 24th, or May 1st, again depending on weather and field conditions.

How long will the season last? Opening day until the end of June. For AAA Division and above, post-season tournaments are 7-10 days after end of regular season. Softball season ends the middle of June.

What days and times are the games played? T-Ball, A, AA and Farm Softball teams will play 1 game per week, usually Saturdays. All other divisions play 2 games per week in May, up to 3 games per week in June.

What equipment will my child need before the first practice or game? HELMET, GLOVE, CLEATS, ATHLETIC SUPPORTER (Minors & above baseball divisions, an athletic cup supporter is required), WARM CLOTHING (especially during the first 3-4 weeks of the season).

What about COVID? All divisions will play and practice under a CBJ-approved mitigation plan, subject to change depending on community risk level. Plan will be posted to www.JuneauLittleLeague.com.

What if I carried over last season's registration fees? All fees carried from last season should appear credited to your account. Any issues? Email treasurer@juneaulittleleague.com.

Players are **required** to provide their own HELMET. GCLL has set up an online store with discounted prices at BSN Sports, an email with link will be sent out. **Look for it Mid-February. Store will close March 20th.**
