ALL PLAYERS wanting to play in Minors or above **MUST** try out for assessment of proper division placement.

4/5 and 5/6 years old: Each player must spend one season in their respective division before advancing.

6 and 7 year old girls: Will be assigned to a Farm softball team unless the parent indicates they want their daughter to play coed T-ball. 7-year old girls with 1 year of Farm or T-Ball experience have the option to attend tryouts for Minor league teams, but they may not be selected to play in that division.

6 and 7 year old boys: Players with 1 year of T-Ball experience may sign up for Farm Division Baseball (no tryout required). Players who have not played before will play in the T-ball Division.

Majors and up can sign up for **POOL PLAY** in their respective division or one division above – see our website for information: www.JuneauLittleLeague.com and click on "Forms" and then "Pool Play".

GASTINEAU CHANNEL LITTLE LEAGUE Frequently Asked Questions



When does registration begin? January 2024 through March 31st (Baseball Minors and above, registration cutoff is March 3rd). Players registering after the registration cutoff will be placed on a waiting list.

Does my child need to attend tryouts? **Baseball:** Players league age 8-16 **AND** wanting to play in Minors or above **must** attend 1 tryout session, even if they've played before.

Softball: Players league age 7 may sign up for Farm (no tryout required) or try out for Minors.

When are tryouts? Dates and locations for baseball and softball tryouts will be announced as soon as dates are available. Please visit www.JuneauLittleLeague.com or on Facebook @GCLLAK for future updates, and to see times for each league age group when available.

When will I find out what team my child will play on? All players who register by March 31st and try out (if required) should be contacted by their team manager no later than April 20th. If you don't hear from a team manager by April 22nd, please contact the Player Agent at PlayerAgent@JuneauLittleLeague.Com

How are teams formed? T-Ball, A, AA, and Farm Softball teams are formed based on player league age and years of playing experience. We honor special placement requests when feasible. All other divisions, players attend tryouts for skill evaluation. Teams are then formed using a draft process to promote parity and competitive play. When will the season begin? When allowed by CBJ Parks and Recreation, depending on weather and field conditions. Practices usually begin the last week of April or first week of May. Opening Day tentatively set for April 27th, or May 4th, again depending on weather and field conditions.

How long will the season last? Opening day until the end of June. For Minors Division and above, post-season tournaments are 7-10 days the after end of regular season. Softball season ends the middle of June.

What days and times are the games played? T-Ball, A, AA and Farm Softball teams will play 1 to 2 games per week. All other divisions play 2 games per week in May, and up to 4 games per week in June.

What equipment will my child need before the first practice or game? HELMET, GLOVE, CLEATS, ATHLETIC SUPPORTER (Minors & above baseball divisions, an athletic cup supporter is required, and a cup is strongly recommended). FACE MASK is strongly recommended for softball infield and pitcher positions.

Players are **required** to provide their own HELMET and GLOVE. GCLL is working on setting up an online store with discounted prices at BSN Sports. An email with link will be sent out when available.
